I am very excited to be back at school and have thoroughly enjoyed the first week back. It has been lovely catching up with all of the Foxes and I hope they are beginning to feel settled once again.

Topic – Modern Europe

Within terms 1 and 2, the children will be studying 'Modern Europe'. The term will begin focussing on our school. This will include making maps and completing surveys. We will then move on to exploring the countries of Europe. We will find out the capital cities of many countries as well as key landmarks. We will also be learning how the features of maps can help to identify the climate of a country. After half term we will continue to learn about 'Modern Europe' but with a specific focus on volcanoes. We will be finding out where volcanoes are located, how volcanoes are formed and erupt and also the impact of volcanoes on tourism of an area.

By the end of the topic the children should be able to answer the key question: Why do people holiday in Europe?

During terms 1 and 2 we are planning lots of fun filled activities including:

- Treasure Hunt (Term 1 Week 2)
- Detective Day (Term 1 Week 6)
- European Market (Term 1 Week 7)
- Making large scale art (TBC)
- Making model volcanoes (TBC)
